Publication Rules

Please note that JMIS publishes manuscripts in Arabic, English, and French. The cover file should include the manuscript title, author (s), affiliation, contact information, and email address.

Paper should be compiled in the following order: the cover, abstract in both languages, keywords, main text introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusion (optional section), references, appendices.

Word limit: typical for JMIS should be between 7000 - 15000 words included tables, references, figures or table caption, footnotes, and endnotes.

Book review should be no more than 2000 words.

JMIS uses APA referencing style.

Journal of Media and Interdisciplinary studies (JMIS) accepts the following types of articles:

- Original articles: these are original manuscript. The work should report scientifically sound experiments and provide substantial amount of new information.
 - The article should include recent and relevant references in the field. The structure should include all mentioned parts above with suggested word count of 7500 10000 (30 40 pages).
- Brief reports: short, observational studies that report preliminary results or a short complete study, or protocol.
 - It usually contains two figure and/or a table, however the materials and methods section should be detailed to insure reproducibility of the present work.
 - The structure is similar to that of an article, with suggested minimum word count of 2500 words (10 pages).
- Book review: short literature critizing and analyzing the content, style, and merit of a recently published book.
 - Full book details should be provided at the beginning of the article.
 - The structure should only include an introduction and discussion of critical points with on sections of conclusion, with suggested word count 1000 2000 words (3 pages).
